



Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine Chinese Government Scholarship for Postgraduates Application Introduction for English Program, 2022

Established in 1958, Tianjin University of Traditional Chinese Medicine (TUTCM) has been listed as one of the co-constructed higher educations by Ministry of Education (MOE), State Administration of Traditional Chinese Medicine (SATCM) and Tianjin Municipal Government, one of the China “Double First-class” universities and Chinese Materia Medica as one of the “Double First-rate” programs. It is the only former State Education Commission (Present MOE) approved International University of Traditional Chinese Medicine and also the hosting institution of Educational Instruction Committee, World Federation of Chinese Medicine Societies (WFCMS), “Educational Aid Center” and “China-ASEAN Educational Training Center” of Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) and Ministry of Education, TCM International Cooperation Center of SATCM, and WFCMS “Belt & Road” Training Center for Chinese Medicine Education Teachers. Adhering the motto of “Strengthening moral education and pursuing academic studies, inheriting and innovating”, TUTCM has developed into a teaching and research oriented university with TCM education as the main body, and covers extensive areas of study, namely as Medicine, Science, Arts, Management, Engineering and Education.

The University has distinguished teaching staff and sufficient resources for students’ internship. Currently it has two National Key Programs of Acupuncture & Moxibustion and *Tuina* and TCM Internal Medicine. There are three affiliated and ten clinical teaching hospitals. Among them, the First Teaching Hospital is a National TCM Clinical Research Center, the National Acupuncture Clinical Research Center, the National Acupuncture Clinical Center and the National Provincial Demonstration TCM Hospital; the Second Teaching Hospital is the treatment center for TCM rare diseases and leading in gynecology and encephalopathy diseases; Baokang Hospital and other teaching hospitals have unique treatment features in TCM Rehabilitation, TCM Orthopedics, TCM Community Health, Clinical Integrative Medicine and etc.

The University has extensive international exchanges and cooperation. It aims to cultivate international applied talents in clinic with solid theoretical foundation and excellent clinical skills which make it enjoy a high reputation world wide. It has formed TCM internationalization talents training system where the bachelor education is the main part. The system also covers master and doctoral education and short and long term certificate studies. As the hosting institution of Educational Instruction Committee of WFCMS, TUTCM has organized experts to formulate *World Standard of Chinese Medicine Undergraduate (Pre-CMD) Education* which has been released by WFCMS and become the first TCM international education standard. The International People-to-People Exchange Institute of Traditional Chinese Medicine jointly established by TUTCM and China Center for International People-to-People Exchange has been chosen in the first batch of National Export Centers of TCM Services by Ministry of Commerce (MOC) and SATCM. It is the only TCM university under the framework of the “20+20 Collaboration Plan between African and Chinese Universities” of MOE. The university has established the first TCM Confucius Institute in Thailand and a TCM training center, the first worldwide TCM Confucius Classroom in Japan, Kobe School of Acupuncture & Moxibustion and *Tuina*, and other overseas institutions. Friendly collaborations have been made between over

40 countries or regions in the world, and that with University of Nottingham has been listed as one of the national strategic cooperation both in the medical fields of U.K. and China.

The new campus of TUTCM is located by Tuanbo Lake in Jinghai District, Tianjin, featured by an in-campus lake view, a symbol of TCM plants and a mainstream of TCM culture. It is a training center for TCM talents, a center for disease prevention by TCM, a center for TCM international education and exchanges, a research center for TCM modernization and a center for TCM culture, together with Tianjin TCM Botanic Garden, Tianjin TCM Museum and etc.

D. For Doctoral Applicants (One of the following):

i. Doctoral Applicants for Acupuncture & Moxibustion and *Tuina*: Master in Medicine or related subjects

ii. Doctoral Applicants for Chinese Materia Medica: Master in Chinese Materia Medica, Pharmacy, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Preparation, Pharmacognosy, Pharmacology or other related majors

E. No more than 35 years old for master's applicants and 40 for doctoral applicants

XI. Application Documents Needed (Please submit PDF or JPG scanned copies, “★” items are mandatory. Photos shot by mobile phone camera are invalid. Uncompleted or blurred documents will affect your scholarship application.)

★A. NOTARIZED highest diploma in Chinese or English

Prospective diploma recipients must submit official document issued by your current school to prove your current student status or expected graduation date. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

★B. NOTARIZED Transcripts in Chinese or English

Transcripts of undergraduate education must be provided for master’s application. Transcripts of undergraduate and postgraduate education must be provided for doctoral application. Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.

★C. Two Recommendation Letters (Written in Chinese or English by 2 different professors or associate professors)

These letters shall describe the applicant’s objectives of studying in China, the cooperation and exchange between the reference or recommending institutes and our university, as well as the evaluation of the applicant’s comprehensive abilities and future growth. ([These letters are important for your application, please do the preparation carefully.](#))

★D. Study Plan in China or research proposal, not less than 1,000 words. The plan can include, but not limited to your willingness to study in China, description of your professional abilities and education background, your research proposal and development plan in the future, and etc.

★E. English proficiency certificate

IELTS, TOFEL or any other English proficiency certificate is required. Native English speaker or applicants whose official Language is English can be exempted.

★F. Photocopy of Valid Passport ([The validity date should be late than September, 2022](#))

★G. Photo (2-inch color photos with white background, full face without hat)

★H. Foreigner Physical Examination Form (Please ask the doctor to fill in the form in

English. The medical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. **Applicants should have the physical exam later than Mar. 10th, 2022 and submit the copy before April 8th, 2022.** Please bring ALL the original documents and attachments when coming to China.)

★ **I. No Criminal Record Report.** The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of non-criminal record issued by the local public security authority. It is usually issued within 6 months before the submission date of the application. (If the applicant is not able to provide this document, please contact us to sign and submit a non-criminal record commitment as a substitute.)

★ **J. Pre-admission letter.** ([This letter is important for your application, please contact us to apply before on-line submission.](#))
